

A NOTE FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE:

As you can see in the above report, while our income continues above 2021 levels, our deficit is increasing.

After paying our July expenses and payroll, as of July 26 our general fund checking account balance has fallen below \$1000. Our committee will be reviewing options and working with Council and the appropriate committees to address the growing deficit before it reaches crisis proportions. At this time we want our members to be aware of our situation. Your support, your suggestions, and your prayers will be appreciated.

FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN REPORT ON 2022 MOBILEPACK IN FOND DU LAC

The 2022 Feed My Starving Children MobilePack in Fond du Lac was directed to the following agencies/countries:

396 BOXES – 85,536 MEALS: 234 children fed for a year have gone to Romania (for Ukrainian refugees) with our partner Reach Now International.

Reach Now International reaches orphans, refugees, internally displaced people, those affected by war, governmental situations, poverty, persecution and other natural conditions and calamities with the gospel and practical help. RNI has distributed FMSC meals in Africa, Asia, the Caribbean, Central America, Eastern Europe and the Middle East to serve these populations.

72 BOXES – 15,552 MEALS: 42 children fed for a year have gone to Haiti with our partner Food for the Poor.

Food for the Poor links the church of the First World with the church of the Third World in a manner that helps both the materially poor and the poor in spirit. FFTP has distributed FMSC meals through its extensive network of partner organizations in the Caribbean, Central America and South America.

The next Fond du Lac FMSC MobilePack will be on March 31 - April 1, 2023.

SOLUTIONS CENTER “ITEM OF THE MONTH”
